We gladly announce our school’s participation in a new project, “**Reaching out through Skype**”, whose aim is to celebrate the European Day of Languages. The theme of this year is “Cultural Heritage-where the past meets the future”.

The participant countries are: Italy, France, the Netherlands, Lithuania, Hungary and Romania. The schools will be asked to prepare a 15- minute Skype presentation. The pupils will share their stories about the examples of their National Cultural Heritage. A travelling picture exhibition will come out of the creative task. The pupils will be asked to look for examples of cultural heritage in their country.
